First Annual General Meeting on 4th April 2011 at the Green Hotel Ice Rink.

Presidents Report – Alastair Hibbert

The president began by welcoming members, new members and guests, Jim Paterson, Alistair Morgan and Lee McCleary who had willingly come forward to help us make up the numbers for our Bonspiel. Apologies for absence were received from Andrew & Irene McLellan, Deborah McLean, Margaret Cant, David Soutar, Kay Adams, Lesley Baillie, Elaine Spain and Frank & Joyce White.

The club was formed in December 2009 with eight founder members- Alastair Hibbert, Alison Soutar, Brian Boyes, Elinor Ritchie, Brian Duncan, Sheila Swan, David Soutar and Kay Adams. Since then the club has gone from strength to strength, beginning season 2010/11 with 24 members and finishing the season with another 17 reserves. It is hoped that season 2011 /12 will see seven or eight teams competing for the league championship.

Treasurers Report

Our treasurer, Brain Boyes gave a full report on the finances of the club prior to the end of the first financial year which is 30th April. The club is in good health after only one full season in existence.

Subscriptions for 2011/12

It was agreed that subscriptions for 2011/2012 will be £20 for all members, reducing to £10 for reserves and new members who join after 1st January.

Special Resolutions

The following Bye Law was accepted unanimously:-

Bye Law 1 – Failure to Appear

A variation to the Royal Club's standard rules to be applied in club games only:-

The Royal Club's rules shall apply except that the game will not be forfeited after 30 minutes and any penalty may be waived at the discretion of the opposition skip where the player concerned is unable to attend through illness or unavoidable circumstances. The maximum penalty applicable for non-attendance after 30 minutes will be six shots and two ends. The opposition skip is not obliged to waive the penalty if he/she feels that insufficient grounds have been presented.

Ice Charges for Reserves - it is proposed that while ice charges are paid by playing members in advance, a gentlemen's agreement will be in place whereby if the reserve plays three or more games for a particular player, then the reserve should offer to reimburse the player being substituted for the third any any subsequent games.

Treasurers Report for Season 2010/2011

I hope that the accounts are fairly self explanatory. As mentioned within the Loch Leven Curling Club's constitution the financial year of the club is 30th April. As we have not yet reached that date I have projected forward the likely closing Income and Expenditure figures. As this is the first annual report I would like to take this opportunity to briefly go over each item on the Projected Income and Expenditure report

Note that these are unaudited figures.

Income :-

Membership Subscription:- This season's Membership Subscription's for membership to the Loch Leven Curling Club was set at £20. To date we have received in; a total of £580. (29 members @ £20 = £580). It should be noted that the committee agreed that any new members that joined as a Reserve, during 2011, would not have to pay their Membership Subscription.

Ice Fees:- The Ice Fees were set at £130, which would enable members to have at least 13 games throughout the season. To date we have received in a total of £3,120. (24 members @ £130 = £3,120).

Mother Club RCCC Fees:- There were 8 members who have Loch Leven Curling Club as their Mother Club. The RCCC Subscription was set at £17 this season therefore the sum of £136 was collected and paid to the RCCC. (8 members @ £17 = £136)

Province Games Ice Fees:- The Club played 2 Province League games during the season and the ice fees totalling £80. were collected from the players for these games.

Reclaimed Ice Fees:- The amount of £190 represents ice fees collected from reserve members for this evenings closing bonspiel and the Province Festive Potty game played in December 2010.

Green Hotel League Ice Fees:- This season the Loch Leven Curling Club entered a team into the Green Hotel League Division 3 which was played over 7 games. Each player in this league paid £10 per game played and the amount of £280.00 was collected over the season.

RCCC Grant:- Following on from a grant received from the RCCC in April 2010 to help start the Loch Leven Club a further £100 grant was received from the RCCC in December 2010 to further help the development of the Loch Leven Curling Club.

Bank Interest (Net):- As Bank interest rates continue to be low the net amount of Bank Interest earned was £1.11.

Expenditure

Ice Fees:- The Ice Fees paid to the Green Hotel, Kinross, make up the bulk of the expenditure, and this season totalled £2,936.

Green Hotel League Ice Fees:- As mentioned in the Income statements the club entered a team into the Green Hotel League Division 3. The cost of the ice payable to the Green Hotel, Kinross was £280.

RCCC Subscriptions:- The RCCC subscriptions this season was set at £17. As we have 8 Mother Club members the cost to the Loch Leven Curling Club was £136.

RCCC Public Liability Insurance:- The RCCC Public Liability Insurance cost this season was £27.00.

Loch Leven Province Subscriptions:- The Loch Leven Province Subscriptions cost this season was £26. This was made up of a £20 Club Annual Subscription along with the Area 7 Incoming Tour Levy at £0.50 per male member as at 30th November 2010, totalling £6.

Overall

The net affect is that the closing balance, as at 30th April 2011 is projected to be £1,262.12.
